COACHES – CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Coaches must respect the rights, dignity and worth of each and every person and treat each equally within the context of the sport.
2. Coaches must place the well being and safety of each player above all other considerations, including the development of performance.
3. Coaches must ensure at the activities they direct or advocate is appropriate for the age, maturity, experience and ability of players.
4. Coaches must always promote the appropriate Code of Conduct and positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play) to players, parents and spectators alike. Never condone violations of the Laws of the Game, behaviour contrary to the spirit of the Laws of the Game or relevant rules and regulations or the use of prohibited substances or techniques.
5. Coaches must adhere to all guidelines laid down within the Constitution and the Rules of BC Soccer.
