Joseph Ratcliffe will be competing for the Kwantlen Polytechnic Eagles, Jacob Georges to Douglas College Royals, with Jeff Cadman entering NCAA play with SFU. Venturing outside BC is Jacob Powell to the Saskatchewan Huskies program and Parker Ross to Stanmore College in the U.K.
